
The Manhattan Mustangs is a 501(c)3 New York Charitable Not-for-Profit Corporation serving our community since 1997.

For more than 20 years, Bailey House has been committed to providing housing and supportive services to the most vulnerable New Yorkers: homeless people with HIV/AIDS. Our housing programs provide homes and vital services to more than 270 men, women and children living with AIDS. Our INVEST NYC program, with 300 clients currently enrolled, provides education for people with AIDS throughout the five boroughs.

In East Harlem, which has the fastest growing number of new HIV infections in New York City, Bailey House offers housing placement and a food pantry, as well as counseling and referrals to our clients. In East Harlem, we also provide homes for 30 families headed by women with AIDS.

Our Technical Assistance and Program Evaluation department conducts workshops and trainings for hundreds of agencies across the city and around the country and has provided valuable support to HIV/AIDS activists from around the world.

Sustaining this vulnerable population in a time when the HIV/AIDS epidemic continues to increase locally and worldwide has been made possible by donors like you. Your support is one of the reasons we have prevailed over the uncertainties and challenges presented by the AIDS epidemic over the past 20 years.
